

LOOKOUT PASS SKI AREA
I-90 at the Idaho/Montana state line

YAHOOO! The ROUTE OF THE HIAWATHA mountain bike or hike trail will open for the 2008 season this Saturday, June 7. Described as "one of the most scenic stretches of railroad in the country", this 15 mile rail-to-trail adventure includes 10 tunnels and 7 sky high trestles. The 1.66 mile long St. Paul Pass tunnel is one of the highlights of the trail. Snowcapped mountains and numerous waterfalls add extra delight, this time of year, and there are 47 historical and interpretive signs along the way that explain the colorful railroad history of this section of the old Milwaukee line.

The best part is... it's all downhill with a shuttle service to take you and your bike back to the top. Restroom facilities and picnic tables are located at the various trailheads.

Trail and shuttle tickets plus bike rental packages and picnic lunches are available at Lookout Pass Ski Area which operates the trail. Helmets and lights are required. Visit www.skilookout.com for complete information including on-line tickets and equipment reservations.
